About Wigram House

Wigram House is a late Victorian mansion block, which has retained many of its original architectural features. The Hall offers single and twin rooms, all with washbasins and shared facilities at a ratio of about one to six. Fully carpeted, the rooms are arranged in traditional hotel style around pods of bathrooms, showers and WCs, which are never far from your bedroom. There are three fully equipped kitchens on each floor for self-catering. On the ground floor, the tastefully decorated common room with TV is a good place to meet people and make new friends.

Things to do

Wigram House is within easy walking distance of many of London's famous sights and attractions, as well as shops, cinemas, pubs, bars, clubs, restaurants, theatres and more.

There are many things to see and do in the area. Here are a few suggestions:

Take your pick of **famous landmarks**, from the London Eye (for further information visit www.londoneye.com) to the Houses of Parliament (visit www.parliament.uk) and Westminster Abbey (visit www.westminster-abbey.org).

Walk along the river Thames or through St James Park to Buckingham Palace, the official home of the Royal Family (for further information visit www.royal.gov.uk) and Banqueting House, with its magnificent ceiling paintings by Rubens (visit www.hrp.org.uk/banquetinghouse).

Walk to Trafalgar Square to see Nelson's Column, the National Gallery and National Portrait Gallery (for further information visit www.nationalgallery.org.uk and www.npg.org.uk), The Strand for theatre, and Covent Garden or the West End for shopping, eating and drinking.

During your stay

Checking-in

The rooms are available from 2pm on the afternoon of your arrival. Check-in is at Reception on the ground floor, where you will be given your room key.

Checking-out time

Please vacate your room by 10am on the morning of your departure to avoid incurring an additional charge.

If you arrive early, you may be able to leave your luggage with Reception. The University, however, cannot be responsible for any loss of or damage to your possessions.

Reception

Reception is on the ground floor and open daily, between 8am and 10pm, and is staffed at night by security personnel.

Left luggage

Visiting other parts of the UK and Europe

London is at the centre of transport links to other parts of the UK and to Europe, and the main London **railway stations** are within easy reach of Wigram House, especially Victoria, which is home to the Gatwick Express. The opening of the Eurostar terminal at St Pancras means that Paris and Brussels are just a couple of hours away.

If you are **flying**, the Heathrow, Gatwick and Stansted Express trains will take you to London's major airports. The 757 Express coach runs to Luton Airport, while a shuttle bus service runs to City Airport. There is also an Airbus service throughout the day from the centre of London to Heathrow and Stansted. No booking is required.
