Presentations

There will be various subject presentations throughout the event. These will be delivered by academic representatives who have an expert knowledge of the courses we offer. Please refer to the presentation timetable (opposite) for more information.

Campus tours

Tours will be available throughout the event and will leave regularly from the main foyer. Simply join a group there and a student ambassador will take you on a tour of our campus and facilities, sharing with you what it's like to be a student at Westminster.

Drop-in advice desks

Staff will be available to answer questions and give advice at our drop-in desks, located in the Gymnasium (on the basement level). As well as providing academic advice, staff will also be available to answer questions about the admissions process, accommodation, financial aspects of university life and student support.

If you require any assistance at all during the event, please ask any member of staff who will be happy to help.

Student ambassadors

We have an experienced team of student ambassadors who will be on hand to look after you during the event. All our ambassadors are students at the University of Westminster and they will guide you to where you want to go, answer any questions you may have and tell you about our Regent Campus.

Refreshments, snacks and lunch can be purchased throughout the event in the Gallery Café leading off the main foyer. There are also vending machines located on campus.

Room Locations

- **Boardroom** is located on the first floor of the building and can be reached by either the main staircase or by taking a lift from the main foyer.
- **Fyvie Hall** is located on the ground floor and is well signposted from the main foyer.
- **Gallery Café** will be serving refreshments and food throughout the event. It is located on the ground floor, next door to the main foyer.
- **Gymnasium** is located on the basement level and can be reached by lift or by taking either of the two staircases that lead from the main foyer.
- **Old Cinema** (also known as NLT1/2) is located on the upper ground floor. Take the main staircase and proceed through the double doors.
- **Toilets** are located on the basement level, close to the main staircase.
