

Summary of the Pre-sessionals course application process

1. Apply for your main degree course.



2. You will receive either a conditional offer or an unconditional offer from the University.



3. Apply for the pre-sessionals English language course.



4. You will receive an offer for the pre-sessionals English language course.



5. You must pay the pre-sessionals course fees and the £4,000 deposit for your main degree course.



6. Once payment is confirmed you will be sent an email asking you to log into the applicant portal to request your CAS .



7. You will be emailed your CAS. You must check that all the information on your CAS is correct. If there are any errors on your CAS, you must contact Tier 4 visas.



8. Apply for your Tier 4 (General) student visa. What application you make will differ on whether you have a conditional or unconditional offer.

If you have a **conditional** offer you will receive a CAS to cover the Pre-sessionals course only and will need to make a second Tier4 application when you have successfully completed the Pre-sessionals course.

If you have an **unconditional** offer, it is likely you will receive one CAS and will only need to make one Tier 4 visa application. If you are unsure, please contact Student Advice. Email: studentadvice@westminster.ac.uk
