

Student receives outcome letter regarding Academic Misconduct

Student submits their appeal stating the grounds and with evidence to the Deputy Registrar (Quality and Standards) normally within 10 working days

Appeal is evaluated by the Deputy Registrar (Quality and Standards) and will make one of the following determinations:

One or more grounds of the appeal have been met, and the case will be referred back to either the Academic Misconduct Meeting or Academic Misconduct Panel Hearing to consider the case afresh

Neither ground for appeal has been met, in which case the appeal is rejected and the University's internal procedures will be complete

Completion of Procedures letter issued to the student

Student may apply to the Office of the Independent Adjudicator (OIA) for an external review of the appeal (if eligible)
