The email header should include your 8-digit Westminster Reference Number and the full name of the scholarship you are applying for. You will not be able to amend your application once we have received it. You need to have a conditional/unconditional offer in place before you can apply for a scholarship.

Selection process:

Please remember that scholarships are limited. Meeting the eligibility criteria does not guarantee that you will receive an award.

All eligible applications will be considered by an awarding panel. The panel members understand that applicants will have a broad range of differing skills, attributes and experiences, so they will give equal consideration to the applicant's academic record, personal circumstances and their answers to the questions posed in the application form.

All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their application within 3 weeks after the deadline.

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INFORMATION

This is a £2000 scholarship towards tuition fees for Home Fee paying Master's students with a minimum 2.1 Honours degree. Students on a 2 year full-time Masters course or a Part time course will receive the scholarship during their first year only. The Scholarship will be paid directly to the University towards your tuition fees. The selection is based on academic merit and personal statement.

ELIGIBILITY

Students must fulfil all criteria below:

- Be a Home student for fee purposes and have an offer for a place on a full time or part time Postgraduate course at the University of Westminster starting in January 2023
- Have a minimum 2.1 Honours Degree
- Students who already have a Master's degree are not eligible to apply
- The following categories of students are not eligible:
 - a. Postgraduate Diploma
 - b. Professional courses (eg RIBA pt III, ACCA, CIMA, CiLEX)
 - c. Conversion courses (eg Graduate Diploma in Law)
 - d. Integrated Masters/MPhil/PhD student
