Selection process:

Please remember that scholarships are limited. Meeting the eligibility criteria does not guarantee that you will receive an award.

All eligible applications will be considered by an awarding panel. The panel members understand that applicants will have a broad range of differing skills, attributes and experiences, so they will give equal consideration to the applicant's academic record, personal circumstances and their answers to the questions posed in the application form.

All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their application within 3 weeks after the deadline.

INFORMATION

The scholarship provides a one off £3000 tuition fee award and is open to Overseas fee-paying students. Selection is based on academic merit and personal statement.

ELIGIBILITY

Students must fulfil all criteria below:

- Be an Overseas student for fee purposes and have an offer for a place on a full-time postgraduate course at the University of Westminster starting in January 2024
- Have a UK equivalent First Class Honours Degree (all courses eligible)
- Have a UK equivalent 2.1 Honours Degree if your course offer is for one of the courses listed below:
 - MA Criminology
 - MA English Language and Linguistics
 - MA Creative Writing: Writing the City
 - MA English Language and Literature
 - MA English Literature: Modern & Contemporary Fiction
 - MA Art and Visual Culture
 - MA Cultural and Critical Studies
 - MA Professional Writing
 - MA Global Development
- Students who already have a master's degree are not eligible to apply unless a master's degree from your home country is a minimum requirement for entry to a UK master's. Please see information in our country pages.
- The following categories of students are not eligible:
 - a. Postgraduate Diploma
 - b. Professional courses (eg RIBA pt III, ACCA, CIMA, CiLEX)
 - c. Conversion courses (eg Graduate Diploma in Law)
 - d. Integrated Masters/MPhil/PhD student
 - e. Part time students
