Terms and Conditions

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following conditions:

- Be an overseas fee-paying student
- Hold an offer to study a full-time Bachelor's degree programme Level 4 (first-year entry)
- Be self-funded (you must be paying for your studies independently rather than being sponsored or in receipt of another scholarship)
- Applicants in receipt of an International Undergraduate Scholarship will not be eligible for any other Scholarships or discounts.
- Meet the conditions attached to your academic offer (if it is a conditional offer) and to the issuance
 of a CAS.
- Maintain your living costs for the duration of your programme of study. Please see our website for further details https://www.westminster.ac.uk/international/visas-and-advice/visas/student-visa
- 1. Undergraduate scholarships of £2500 are awarded towards tuition fees for one year only, in the first academic year of study. Students must pay any additional costs incurred for subsequent years of study or extensions to their standard course duration.
- 2. The scholarship will be paid directly to the University's Finance Offices on behalf of the student by the Scholarships office toward tuition fees in November of your first academic year and cannot be used towards the £5,500 deposit payment.
- 3. All decisions are made by the University and are final. Any applications submitted after the published deadline will not be considered. All applicants will be informed of the outcome within 4 weeks after the deadline. Please note we are unable to provide individual feedback on applications.
- 4. You can only be awarded one scholarship. Students applying for other University of Westminster Awards (such as agent and partner scholarships) will only be considered for one.
- 5. We will consider requests to defer your scholarship to another academic year but the you must contact the scholarships team to confirm.
- 6. You must contact the scholarships team before making any changes to your programme of study/course transfers.
- 7. Recipients of this award are expected to act in an ambassadorial capacity, to provide student profiles or testimonials if requested, and to attend scholarship or recruitment events as required to include the annual scholarship reception.
