#### Introduction

The University of Westminster is proud to announce that Land Securities, the largest commercial property development and investment company in the UK, is supporting underrepresented groups in higher education through funded scholarships through its Landsec Futures programme.

The announcement demonstrates the University of Westminster's as well as Land Securities commitment to Diversity, Equality, and Inclusion in the real estate and property sector. Both the University and Land Securities are committed to providing opportunities and support to ensure that people from every background can realise their true potential.

The scholarship will support one postgraduate student from a BAME background with a course offer to study MSc Real Estate Development starting in September 2023. This represents a huge opportunity to catapult the chosen scholars' career, graduating as a Land Securities Scholar, and opening up many doors to the profession.

One living expenses scholarship is available for a Home Fee paying Master's student on the MSc Real Estate Development course for the duration of their one-year degree. Students will receive £10,000 in their first year of study. This is to support with rent, bills, food, transport, course materials and should enable you to reduce your part-time working hours in employment, to free up time to dedicate yourself fully to your studies to reach your true potential.

£5000 will be paid into your nominated bank account in October and £5000 in January. Students on a part-time course will receive the scholarship during their first year only.

# Eligibility

In order to apply you must:

- Be a Home student for fee purposes and have an offer from the University of Westminster for a place on the full-time or part-time MSc Real Estate Development course starting in September 2023
- Be from a Black, Asian, Minority Ethnic background and/or female student
- Have a minimum 2.2 Honours Degree
- Be the first in your family to go to University
- Have a household income of less than £25,000 per annum
