# Paying for travel

- **Student Oyster** is the best way to get around London's public transport network
- Debit/Credit cards touch in and out either using card or bank account set up on your mobile phone
- **30% of travel** in London with TFL student card
- An **Oyster card** can be used on the Bus, Tube, DLR, Tram, London Overground and some National Rail services
- **Don't use cash!** Cash single fares for all tube journeys are very expensive.
- **Buses** – **several** journeys within an hour , charges you only once an hour
