Paying for travel

- Student Oyster is the best way to get around London's public transport network
- Debit/Credit cards touch in and out either using card or bank account set up on your mobile phone
- 30% of travel in London with TFL student card
- An Oyster card can be used on the Bus, Tube, DLR, Tram, London Overground and some National Rail services
- Don't use cash! Cash single fares for all tube journeys are very expensive.
