You will not be able to amend your application once we have received it. You need to have a conditional/unconditional offer in place before you can apply for a scholarship.

Selection process:

Please remember that scholarships are limited. Meeting the eligibility criteria does not guarantee that you will receive an award.

All eligible applications will be considered by an awarding panel. The panel members understand that applicants will have a broad range of differing skills, attributes and experiences, so they will give equal consideration to the applicant's academic record, work experience, personal circumstances and their answers to the questions posed in the application form. Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed by members of the panel.

All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their application within 3 weeks after the deadline.

Richard Antwi was a London born lawyer, music manager and entrepreneur passionate about music, the arts and growing new talent. The Richard Antwi scholarship aims to continue this legacy by supporting black and minority ethnic students on the MA in Music Business Management to realise their full potential. Scholarship recipients are encouraged to continue this legacy and build a more vibrant and inclusive music industry.

INFORMATION

One scholarship is available for a Home Fee paying Master's student. This scholarship covers the full tuition fee costs for the MA Music Business Management course at the University of Westminster and provides a stipend of £22,000 (distributed in 12 monthly instalments for full-time students and 24 monthly instalments for part-time students).

ELIGIBILITY

Students must fulfil all criteria below:

- Be a Home student for fee purposes and have an offer for the full time or part time MA Music Business Management course at the University of Westminster starting in September 2024.
- EU students with Home fee status are eligible to apply.
- Show development potential in your supporting statement. Demonstrable passion and experience or interest in music, music and technology or music management; financial need. Work experience in the field or academic excellence is preferable.
- Students who already have a Master's degree are not eligible to apply.
- This scholarship is designed to support under-represented Black and Minority Ethnic students and promote access to higher education. As such, all applicants must be from a Black and Minority Ethnic background.
