All eligible applications will be considered by an awarding panel. The panel members understand that applicants will have a broad range of differing skills, attributes and experiences, so they will give equal consideration to the applicant's academic record, personal circumstances and their answers to the questions posed in the application form.

All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their application 3 weeks after the deadline.

# Postgraduate Sanctuary Scholarship 2022/23

---

The University will be allocating one Postgraduate Sanctuary Scholarship in total in 2022/23. The scholarship is provided to support students who have been granted Indefinite Leave to Remain or Discretionary Leave to Remain by the home office. The selection is based on financial need and the merit of the application.

---

## INFORMATION

One scholarship is available. The scholarship covers the full tuition fee cost and provides a maintenance payment of £6,000 (£3,000 per year for part-time students, maximum of two years). The scholarship will be paid 50% in October and 50% in February into your nominated bank account each year.

---

## ELIGIBILITY

Students must fulfil all criteria below:

- You must have an offer from the University of Westminster for a place on a full-time or part-time master's course starting in September 2022.
- You must currently be living in the UK.
- You must be under 25 years of age when you begin your degree.
- You must have been granted Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR) or Discretionary Leave to Remain (DLR) by the Home Office; this must be the sole reason why you do not qualify for student funding or home fee status. ILR status holders must have been residing in the UK for less than 3 years.
- Students who already have a master's degree are **not** eligible to apply.

*Please note, once you are awarded a status by the Home Office that allows you access to student finance (tuition fee loans, etc.), you will not receive any outstanding maintenance payment.*
