

Forms of Acceptable Supporting Documentation/Evidence for Disability Learn Support

- DSA needs assessment reports
- Diagnostic report
- GP letter
- Consultant letter
- Hospital discharge summaries or care plans
- Neurological or pain clinic
- Letter from a nurse or allied health professional (e.g. physiotherapist)
- Letter from a psychiatrist, psychologist, or mental health nurse
- Wellbeing, Mental Health, Counselling or Specialist Mentors service letter (external or internal)

Education-Based Evidence (Previous Adjustments): School/college support plans, such as:

- EHCP (Education, Health and Care Plan)
- IEP (Individual Education Plan)
- SEN Support documentation
- Learning support profiles
- Access Arrangement evidence from Sixth Form, such as:
- Confirmation of extra time, reader, scribe, use of a laptop, etc.
- Letter from a SENCo or Learning Support Coordinator confirming: What adjustments were in place

Other forms of evidence:

- Letter from a social worker, youth support worker, or case manager
- DWP disability-related benefits documentation, such as: PIP (Personal Independence Payment) award letter
- Letter from a support organisation, charity, or advocate (if they are involved in care and can confirm impact)
- Reports from rehabilitation services
