FOR GRADUANDS

- Your name will be called as you cross the stage and you will have the opportunity to shake the Vice-Chancellor's hand. Alternatively, you can clasp your hands in front of you or doff your cap!
- To ensure respect to all graduands, please remain in the hall until the ceremony concludes.
- Please respect the audience and the occasion by following instructions and not doing anything which might disrupt the ceremony.
- Confetti cannons and similar devices are not allowed at graduation as they can cause damage to venues, create a mess that's difficult to clean, and may upset attendees by disrupting the event.

FOR GUESTS

- Feel free to cheer, whistle and celebrate your graduand as they cross the stage.
- Please remain seated and in the auditorium until the end of the ceremony.
- Please keep walkways and aisles clear during the ceremony.
- No celebratory bouquets of flowers will be permitted in the auditorium. These can be left by the entrance to the auditorium and collected once the ceremony has ended.
