University of Westminster Home Postgraduate Scholarships

Terms and Conditions

- 1. To be eligible, applicants must meet all of the following conditions.
- Course offer for a place on a full-time or part-time postgraduate degree programme for the current academic year.
- Assessed as Home student for fee purposes
- Have met all eligibility criteria as outlined on the application form
- Not already have a Masters degree
- 2. Students can only receive one scholarship from the University of Westminster, they could however be eligible for other bursaries or awards and can also receive external scholarships as well as the University of Westminster Alumni discount.
- 3. Postgraduate scholarships are for one year only and are paid directly to the University in November towards tuition fee costs. Students on a 2 year or part time Masters course will receive the scholarship in their first year only.
- 4. If you experience serious academic difficulties (e.g. failing a module, filing mitigating circumstances, suspension, etc.) you must inform the Scholarships Office immediately.
- 5. If an awardee decides to change programmes, the student will be entitled to keep the scholarship provided that the new course and mode of study meets the eligibility criteria. All changes must be approved by the Scholarships Office beforehand.
- 6. If an awardee decides to withdraw, the scholarship will terminate at the date of withdrawal. Any payments made to the student will not need to be returned.
- 7. The following categories of students are not eligible:
 - a. Postgraduate Diploma
 - b. Professional courses (eg RIBA pt III, ACCA, CIMA, CiLEX)
 - c. Conversion courses (eg Graduate Diploma in Law)
 - d. Integrated Masters/MPhil/PhD
- 8. All decisions are made by the scholarship panel and are final. Any applications submitted after the published deadline will not be considered. All applicants will be informed of the outcome within 3 weeks after the deadline. Please note we are unable to provide individual feedback.
- 9. Scholarships cannot be deferred to another academic year. If you wish to defer your course entry, you will need to submit a new application for a scholarship.
