You need to have a conditional/unconditional offer in place before you can apply for a scholarship.

#### Selection process:

Please remember that scholarships are limited. Meeting the eligibility criteria does not guarantee that you will receive an award.

All eligible applications will be considered by an awarding panel. The panel members understand that applicants will have a broad range of differing skills, attributes and experiences, so they will give equal consideration to the applicant's academic record, personal circumstances and their answers to the questions posed in the application form.

All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their application within 3 weeks after the deadline.

#### **INFORMATION**

The scholarship provides a one off £2000 tuition fee award and is open to Overseas fee-paying students. Selection is based on academic merit and personal statement.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Students must fulfil all criteria below:

- Be an Overseas student for fee purposes and have an offer for a place on a full-time postgraduate course at the University of Westminster starting in January 2023
- Have a minimum UK equivalent 2.1 Honours Degree
- Students who already have a Master's degree are not eligible to apply unless otherwise stated in the <u>overseas academic qualifications equivalency guide</u>.
- The following categories of students are not eligible:
  - a. Postgraduate Diploma
  - b. Professional courses (eg RIBA pt III, ACCA, CIMA, CiLEX)
  - c. Conversion courses (eg Graduate Diploma in Law)
  - d. Integrated Masters/MPhil/PhD student
  - e. Part time students
